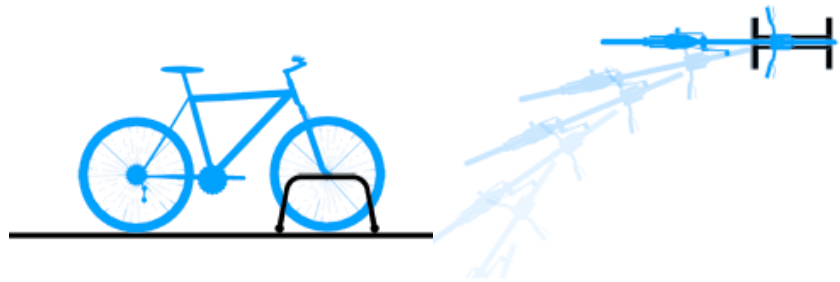

## Hooks



Hooks are an inexpensive way of hanging a bike from a wall or ceiling. The bike is attached by either the handlebars, a wheel, or often in a vertical position to save space. Installation is by screws into wall/ceiling.

### Typical Context of Use:

Indoor domestic, garages, garden walls.

### Number of Bikes per Unit:

1.

### Approximate Cost per Bike:

From £4.50 to £15.99.

### Locking Opportunities/ Lock Compatibility:

None / None .

### Ease of Use/Time to Lock:

Easy to use for those who can easily lift their bike.

### Strengths:

- Makes use of under space
- Compatible with a wide range of bicycles
- Lifetime: 5-15 years depending on the quality of the product

### Weaknesses:

- Will not suit low ceilings
- Offers no locking opportunities
- Offers no storage opportunities for clothes and accessories
